
# DSTT State of Good Repair

## Why We Are Here

- The Downtown Seattle Transit Tunnel (DSTT) is anticipated to transfer from KCM to ST in 2020
- The DSTT Program will oversee a portfolio of projects that will bring the facility to a State of Good Repair
- Seeking approval to contract with WSP as the DSTT General Engineering Consultant (On-Call up to \$10M)

#### GEC Contract Key Features

- PART 1: Program Management
- PART 2: Engineering & Final Design
- Task Order based contract for more flexibility
- Construction phases are executed through separate contracts and funding
- Option for construction management services



#### Immediate Task Order Plan

- Task Order 1: This scope will cover the program management piece of the effort which will last the life of the contract.
- Task Order 2: The scope will cover LIDAR scanning and base mapping to provide a resource for future work.
- Remaining Task Orders: will be executed in order of project priority based upon the results of Task Order 1.
