



# A New Line of Business

- Opens in 2024
- Two Corridors (I-405 and SR 522/ NE 145th)

#### **BRT Systems Elements of Success**

- Transit speed, reliability and access improvements
- BRT stations (signage, shelter, amenities)
- Parking facilities
- New BRT bus fleet
- Bus operations and maintenance facility
- Branding
- Rider information system


#### **Station Design Concept**



## **Environmental Approach**

- Environmental Review of BRT Program
  - SR 522/NE 145<sup>th</sup> BRT
  - I-405 BRT
  - Bus Base North (Operation and Maintenance Facility)
- Components with independent utility being advanced separately
  - NE 44<sup>th</sup> (I-405), NE 85<sup>th</sup> (I-405), and Bothell BAT Lanes (SR 522)





\*Construction for most of the BRT projects are expected to begin by 2023 and be completed by 2024. Construction of some elements may begin before 2023 and others may occur after service starts in 2024.




## SR 522 / NE 145<sup>th</sup> BRT Project Overview

- 8,000-9,000 daily riders
- 8 miles, 6 cities
- Transit speed and reliability improvements:
  - Business Access and Transit lanes along SR 522
  - Intersection improvements/queue jumps
- 12 Stations:
  - 10 new station locations
  - Station at 145<sup>th</sup> LRT Station
  - Shared station at NE 195<sup>th</sup> with I-405 BRT
- 3 new parking facilities/access improvements





### SR 522 / NE 145th BRT Project Components






## **Bothell BAT Lanes**

#### Key features:

- Funding construction of Business Access and Transit Lanes
- SR 522 / NE 145<sup>th</sup> BRT component funded in ST3
- Complete: Q4 2020
- Start of BRT service: 2024





# **Construction Funding Agreement**

### Sound Transit Responsibilities

- Review and concur with all change orders
- Reimburse the City for actual costs
- Attend construction meetings, with access to site

### **City of Bothell Responsibilities**

- Serve as project administrator for construction and construction management
- Notify, consult, and gain approval from Sound Transit prior to the execution of all change orders
- Provide Sound Transit with monthly status reports, schedule updates, and invoices





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

# I-405 BRT Project

#### 37-mile corridor: Lynnwood to Burien

- Proposed refined project:
  - 11 BRT stations across 8 cities
  - 3 new/expanded parking facilities
  - 1 transit center
  - Connections to Link light rail in Lynnwood, Bellevue and Tukwila
  - Estimated 25,800 riders daily by 2040
  - Start of service in 2024








### **Project Refinements:** North Line

- Shoulder improvements for transit to extend North of Canyon Park
- UW Bothell/Cascadia: On going discussions on the connection between SR 522/NE145th and I-405 BRT
- NE 85<sup>th</sup>: Reduced scope for bus-only lanes. Explore transit speed, reliability and access improvements





## **Refined Project Performance**

#### Increased ridership estimates by:

- North corridor boardings: +12%
- South corridor boardings: +22%
- Total boardings: +17%


#### Improved travel time estimates by:

- North corridor: 5 minutes
- South corridor: 7-9 minutes



## **Bus Base North**

- Critical Path Complete by 2023 for vehicle fleet
- Screening Criteria (30+ sites):
  - 12+ acres
  - Compatible zoning
  - Proximity to I-405 and SR 522 on major arterials
  - Minimize sensitive area impacts (wetlands)
  - Vacant or minimal displacements
  - Flat
- Representative site: Canyon Park, Bothell

#### WSP USA, Inc. Scope of work:


- Conceptual Design
  - Fieldwork, data collection and technical studies
  - Stakeholder involvement
  - Advance design for stations and other work (survey, geotech, ROW)
  - Evaluate potential BRT vehicle Fleet
- Environmental Review: Develop NEPA/SEPA documentation



- Serves the future NE 44th Street BRT station




