# **Proposed action**

Authorizes contingency for the East Link Systems Final Design contract with LTK Engineering Services to provide increased design support during construction services for the East Link Extension in the amount of \$3,000,000, for a new total authorized contract amount not to exceed \$27,361,805.

# **Key features summary**

- This action provides additional funding for design support during construction (DSDC) that was not anticipated in the original budget. These design needs include:
  - Changes identified by Sound Transit as a result of value engineering proposals from the systems contractor.
  - Changes related to Connect 2020 work which reduced rider impacts by single-tracking during tie-in construction.
  - Systems Integration Testing support prior to revenue service.
  - Expedited civil-coordinated shop drawings to help maintain construction schedule.
  - Increased responses to requests for information from the civil contractor due to coordinated systems changes.

# Background


East Link Extension extends light rail 14 miles from downtown Seattle to downtown Bellevue and the Overlake area of Redmond via I-90, with stations serving Rainier Avenue/I-90, Mercer Island, South Bellevue, Downtown Bellevue, Overlake Hospital, the Bel-Red Corridor, Overlake Village, and the Overlake Transit Center. The East Link project route, profiles, and station locations were selected by the Sound Transit Board on July 28, 2011, and amended on April 25, 2013. In April 2015, the Sound Transit Board established the baseline budget and schedule for the project. Revenue service between Seattle and the Overlake Transit Center is forecasted for 2023.

In September 2012, LTK Engineering Services was selected through a competitive procurement to perform final design for the Systems work elements of the East Link Extension. In April 2016, the final design contract was amended to include DSDC for all systems design elements on the East Link project. DSDC work includes items such as the review of contractor submittals, response to contractor requests for information (RFIs), special inspections, coordination of permit requirements and other engineering and architectural design efforts as needed to support the construction activities.

In December 2016, the Systems construction contract negotiations required a large number of owner directed design changes to reach an agreed upon price. Then in April 2018 the East Link Extension tie-in method was changed from full shutdown to the Connect 2020 automated single tracking. These changes resulted in a significant number of System drawings being changed, primarily in the communications, system wide electrical, and IDS sections, all of which required coordination with the ongoing civil contracts.

In March 2019, the Downtown Bellevue to Spring District civil contractor identified that the development of coordinated shop drawing of civil and systems conduits was affecting the critical path of station completion requiring additional levels of DSDC support to mitigate the schedule impact.

# Project status



Projected completion date for East Link Systems construction: Q4 2021

Project scope, schedule and budget summary are located on page 55 of the December 2019 Agency Progress Report.

#### **Procurement information**

A request for qualifications (RFQ) was advertised on February 29, 2012. Two statements of qualifications (SOQ) were submitted by interested teams. The SOQs were reviewed and evaluated for responsiveness to the criteria in the RFQ. LTK Engineering Services was deemed most qualified. A Cost Plus Fixed Fee type contract was determined appropriate for the purposes for A&E services. On September 4<sup>th</sup> 2012, Sound Transit entered into Contract AE 0027-12 with LTK Consulting Services, INC dba LTK Engineering Services as the firm selected to perform final design for the Systems work elements of the East Link Extension. The contract also includes an option for Systems Design Services During Construction (DSDC) including submittal reviews and systems coordination for the following contract packages:

- o E130 Seattle IDS to South Bellevue
- o E320 South Bellevue
- o E330 Downtown Bellevue Tunnel
- E335 Downtown Bellevue to Spring District
- E340 Bel-Red
- o E360 SR520 to Overlake Village Station
- o E750 Systems Contract

Sound Transit exercised the option to add DSDC services with Change Order 003 effective July 6, 2016.

### Fiscal information

This action is within the baseline budget and sufficient monies remain after approval of this action to fund the remaining work in the final design phase as contained in the current cost estimates.

The baseline budget for the East Link Extension project is \$3,677,150,000. Within the final design phase, \$12,217,000 has been allocated to the budget line item for DSDC Systems. The proposed action would commit \$3,000,000 as contingency to this line item and leave a remaining budget balance of \$2,762,000.
