- King County will reimburse East Link for administration, design and construction changes in the amount of ~\$340,000.
- Today we are here request a recommendation to the full ST Board for authorization for the CEO to execute a betterment agreement with King County.
- We need Board authority to enter into the underlying betterment agreement, not for the change order itself per R2018-40




Height of the hospital path bridge for a mixing zone:






Exhibit C - Wilburton Station Modifications and North Stairs Plans PCI 180 NE 8th St Pedestrian Bridge Impacts MAY 2020
