- 2 parking facilities
- Operations & Maintenance Facility (OMF): System-wide facility
- Pre-COVID schedule: Start of revenue service 2036

Consultant procurement

- Request for Qualifications Issued: December 17, 2019
- Three (3) Statements of Qualifications received
- Kimley-Horn and Associates highest ranked firm
- Scope:
 - Phase 1: Alternatives Development (this action)
 - Phase 2: Draft EIS & Conceptual Engineering (option, future action)
 - Phase 3: Final EIS & Preliminary Engineering (option, future action)

Contract commitments exceed Sound Transit's small business and DBE goals


