

Railroad C&M Agreement (5th Street NW)

- (M2021-12) Construction and Maintenance Agreement and Real Property Rights Acquisition.
- Hensel Phelps will design and construct civil-related crossing improvements.
- Sound Transit will reimburse BNSF for work performed.
- Improvements will be owned and maintained by the City/BNSF.
- Temporary easement to implement proposed improvements.
- Total authorized amount not to exceed
 - = \$851,818





Railroad C&M Agreement (7th Street NW)

- (M2021-13) Construction and Maintenance Agreement and Real Property Rights Acquisition.
- Improvements required as part of the Environmental determination; Traffic mitigation / signalization work.
- HP will design and construct civil-related crossing improvements.
- Sound Transit will reimburse BNSF for work performed.

Improvements will be owned and maintained by City/BNSF.

- Temporary and Permanent easements to implement proposed improvements.
- Total authorized amount not to exceed= \$818,060




U.S. DoT Awards Grant

- In December 2020, the U.S. Department of Transportation awarded a \$1,421,500 grant to the Agency to improve safety at the existing 5th Street Northwest and 7th Street Northwest crossings.
- Commuter Authority Rail Safety Improvement (CARSI) Grant awarded by FHWA.
- "..install new crossing gate arms, pedestrian signals, elevated concrete pedestrian pads and detectable warning devices and improve flashing-lights.."


