Why we are here

Motion:

Delegation of authority for CEO to enter into and amend Long-Term Carbon Free Utility Agreements

- Any long-term, fixed priced product to purchase renewable or carbon free (hydropower) product
- Power purchase agreements, such as Green Direct from PSE





Benefits of Motion

Rationale:

Streamline approval process in light of expanding opportunities:

- Anticipate additional future agreements with multiple energy utilities
- As an example, both Green Direct Phase 1 and Green Direct Phase 2 agreements require amendment

Guidelines

Thresholds for delegation:

Agreement must be a power purchase or similar utility agreement for carbon-free energy that:

- Requires no up-front capital investment by the agency
- Offers cost-effective financial terms and other co-benefits
- Is within the agency's legal authority
- Demonstrates achievement towards agency sustainability goals
- Is consistent with adopted budgets and financial plans


Reporting

Environmental Benefits

- Green Direct Phase 1
 & 2 = 96% reduction in
 GHG emissions within existing electricity
 portfolio
- Makes current Link light rail alignment the nation's first major light rail system to run on 100% carbon free power
