

- Action: Consider recommendation to the ST Board to execute a funding agreement with the City of Shoreline








#### SR 522/NE 145th BRT: Current Status

- Environmental Review Complete
- Board selected SR 522/145<sup>th</sup> BRT Project to be built
- Final Design underway
- Right of Way acquisition initiated
- Target and affordable schedules 2026 revenue service

### Key features


- Shoreline will manage right of way acquisition, and construction
- Transit Priority meter will give priority to Stride and partner transit agency buses
- Transit priority meter significantly reduced length of Business
  Access and Transit (BAT) lanes
- Lynwood Link Extension construction improvements reduced to account for a smaller construction foot print
- Sound Transit' contribution is capped at \$10M
- Sound Transit's apprenticeship and other small/disadvantaged business participation goals will be include in all contracts


