

Event 3: NOV 21st, 2021 @10:30 PM


- Fatal Stabbing
- 1 Person Deceased, 2nd Person injured (gunshot)



Mount Baker in Context to Overall System


Top 10 Security Event Stations: Two-month trend (Sept –Oct 21)

Security Events




Top 5 + Mount Baker: Two-month trend (Sept –Oct 21)

Top 5 Stations + Mount Baker


Availability of Resources

Contract Security and Law Enforcement

- Contract security provider Securitas 75% staffing
- Contract security provider Phoenix Protective (mobile patrols) 93%
- King County Sheriff's deputies (Sound Transit Police) 70%

Deployment of Resources – Contract Security

Sound Transit's General Deployment Strategy:

- Use technology over staffing
- Contract Security used for static postings
 - High Risk Stations
 - Terminus Stations
 - Underground Stations
 - Revenue Vehicle Storage
- Mobile Security Patrols for all other facilities, park and rides, garages, and warehouses.



Deployment of Resources – King County Sheriff

Sound Transit's General Deployment Strategy:

- Not used for fixed postings
- Dispatched Call for Service response
- Patrols geographic zones with a focus on high event locations (Top 5 stations)
- Responds to rail collisions to reduce delays in returning to service

Actions taken and ongoing efforts

Actions Taken

Increased Contract Security and Law Enforcement Presence

- Increased security patrols in late 2020 due to community concerns.
- June 2021 Increased security patrols to 6 per shift (12 per day).

Actions Taken

Increased Contract Security and Law Enforcement Presence

- November 2021 Fixed security post, our goal is to provide 24 hour a day security coverage to the maximum extent possible until the end of 2021.
- December 2021 Increasing daily law enforcement patrols at least 5 hours per day randomly throughout the day, through the month of December.

Ongoing Efforts

- Safety and community relations team will be participating in the biweekly community and elected calls.
- Continue to be on the South Precinct Interagency Calls hosted by the Seattle Police Department.
- Expedite improved lighting at the station (once supply chain issue is resolved).

Ongoing Efforts

- Develop TOD affordable housing opportunities on adjacent properties currently encumbered by homeless encampment.
- Work with community to activate the Mt. Baker plaza area.
