This action – Motion No. M2021-20

To implement the actions identified in Motion M2020-55, additional ancillary work must be performed

- Completed mostly by WSDOT and utilities; can be jurisdictions and affected third-parties
- Engineering design/plan review and ensure regulatory compliance and compatibility
- Estimated to cost less than \$1.5 million through July 2021
- Under CEO's delegated authority to approve
- All work is funded in the Board-adopted 2021 budget
- Does not limit the Board's ability to realign the capital program



Next Steps

• Today: Consider do-pass recommendation for M2021-20

Authorizing the chief executive officer to execute ancillary agreements and task orders within the authority delegated under the Board's Procurement, Agreements and Delegated Authority Policy that are necessary to implement the near-term actions approved by the Board in Motion No. M2020-55 so long as they are included in the Board-adopted budget and the total cost of the work does not limit the Board's ability to realign the capital program.
