Improvements such as brighter lighting would enhance overall appearance in addition to safety as well as broken lighting repairs done more quickly.

Cleanup should include not just trash but pressure washing the ground for urine smells and pressure washing exterior wall areas and seating where grime and dirt that have accumulated over time.
