King Street Station Platform Area Improvements

Background

- Improve passenger access to/ from the King Street Station platform area
- Address overcrowding on the stairs and elevators
- Alternatives Analysis: Q1 2021 Q3 2022
- Target Completion Date: 2036





King Street Station Current Conditions




Summary of Alternatives Screening

- Evaluated 10 options to improve passenger flow and connections to the surrounding area and are advancing 3 for further study and environmental review
- Common elements in the 3 options include:
 - Extended platforms to the south to accommodate longer trains
 - Up to 5 additional staircases and 2 elevators to improve vertical circulation
 - Creation of a concourse level, above the platform at the same elevation as 4th Ave S & the Weller St Bridge
- Additional options include connections via 2nd Ave S and 4th Ave S including a pedestrian bridge over 4th Ave S

Financial plan cost and schedule

- Sounder South Expansion Program, which includes King Street Station (KSS) Platform Area Improvements, current financial plan is \$1,241 million in 2022\$.
- The overall Sounder South Expansion Program is being managed within the Agency's Financial Plan with a completion date of 2046, while the KSS project is estimated to cost approximately \$60 million with completion in 2036.
- This action is consistent with the schedule and financial plan adopted by the Board in Resolution No. R2021-05, and does not impact the affordability of any other system expansion project

Today's Action

Approve Motion No. M2022-76:

- Authorize the chief executive officer to execute contract modification with David Evans and Associates Inc.
- To conduct Conceptual Engineering and Environmental and Project Coordination Support for the King Street Station Platform Area Improvements Project
- In the amount of \$3,136,067 which includes a 10 percent contingency, for a new total authorized contract amount not to exceed \$12,525,192



Sounder S Capacity Expn: Authorized Project Allocation \$21.1M




