# 2023 budget priorities

- Maintain long term financial sustainability
- Resource allocation consistent with August 2021 capital expansion resolution and agency DEIC priorities
- Operating resources to support new services and assets
- Service levels/budget reflect current ridership demand



# 2023 proposed sources: \$3.1B

- Sales and use tax is 65% of all 2023 total revenue and financing sources
- Federal grants lower in 2023 due to ARP funding in 2022
- Fare revenues increase with increased ridership
- Higher ORCA regional reimbursement

# East Link Extension, \$128.8M

- Advances civil and systems contract work.
- Testing, commissioning and other start-up related activities





### Downtown Redmond Link Extension, \$236.3M

- Continue major construction of guideway and trackwork, stations and Marymoor Village Garage.
- Systems work begins and in full production.





# Federal Way Link Extension, \$442.8M

- Major construction continues with garages, stations, and guideway / trackwork.
- Traffic Mitigation construction contract anticipated award and NTP by Q4.
- ROW acquisitions & relocations.





# Lynnwood Link Extension, \$431.1M

- Substantial completion of civil construction
- Systems procurement and installation of major equipment, completion of permanent power
- Testing and commissioning activities.





# NE 130th Station (Lynnwood Link), \$26.9M

- Completion of heavy civil construction by the Lynnwood Link contractor
- Award and commencement of the station finishes contract.





# Light Rail Vehicle Fleet Expansion, \$121.5M

- Completion of the final car shell production
- Deliveries target 32 vehicles for a total of 140
- Planned conditional acceptance of an additional 40 vehicles for a total of 111 of 152.





# North Corridor MOW, \$8.8M

 ROW Phase represents 90% of Proposed Budget for property acquisition.

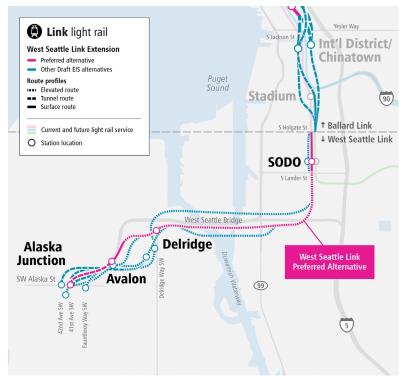

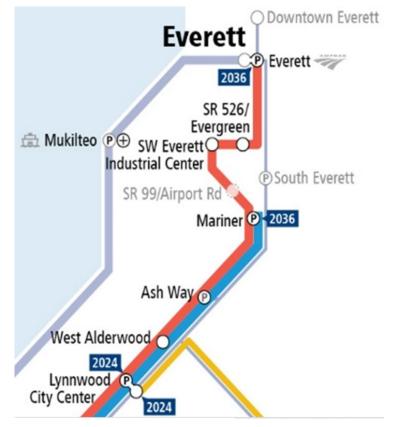

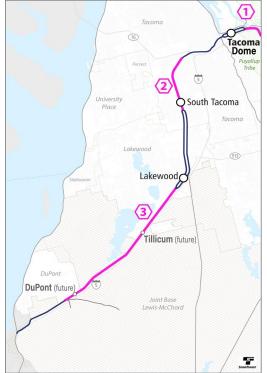

     will affect 2023 annual budget
  - Award design-build contracts and issue Notice to Proceed for all three projects





# System Expansion Stride

# I-405 Bus Rapid Transit, \$177.2M

- Baseline in Q2 2023
- Completion of final design
- Continue construction by WSDOT (NE 44th, NE 85th Interchange and Brickyard to SR 527)
- Execute construction agreements with WSDOT (TIBS) and City of Renton (P&R),
- Begin procurement for station fit up and vehicles
- Acquisition of easements along the corridor





# SR 522/NE 145<sup>th</sup> BRT, \$87.0M

- Baseline in Q2 2023
- Completion of final design
- Continue construction of I-5 / NE 145<sup>th</sup> roundabout, Bothell NE 185th street rebuild,
- Continue procurement of Bus Operating Technology System,
- Start procurement of vehicle fleet,
- Continue ROW acquisition





# Bus Base North, \$24.0M

- Baseline in Q2 2023
- Completion of final design
- Start construction procurement process for Bus Base North
- Address covenants, conditions, and restrictions (CC&Rs)

# Bus System Expansion, \$32.0M

- Contribution to RapidRide C paving completion & Madison BRT construction
- Contribution to Pierce Transit Pacific Ave/ SR 7 BRT
- Work postponed due to realignment
  - Bus on Shoulder
  - North Sammamish Park & Ride
  - Any additional RapidRide funding agreement
