## *Seattle Mayor Bruce Harrell*

Dear Sound Transit Board members,

During today's Board meeting, Sound Transit staff are presenting a report on the Ballard Link Extension, specifically a Denny Station status report, that was directed in Motion No. M2023-18. I am pleased that staff are providing the Board with this update and meeting the May 25, 2023, deadline set for this status report. Unfortunately, I am unable to attend the Board meeting this month and wanted to send along my thoughts in advance of the Board discussion.

First, I would like to extend my sincere thanks and gratitude to the South Lake Union community that reached out to the City of Seattle and the Sound Transit Board with their concerns about the impacts of station construction and street closures. Their concerns are real, and we take them seriously. The City of Seattle continues to have significant concerns about the impacts of a 4-year, full closure of Westlake Avenue in the current DT-1 preferred alternative.

Second, I want to thank the Sound Transit staff, City of Seattle staff, and technical experts and stakeholders for their involvement and subject matter expertise applied to this project over the last 60 days. We asked for an expedited review and it is clear that we learned more about the alternatives in South Lake Union. I also want to thank the Sound Transit Board for allowing this additional review to proceed.

Given the updated information from Sound Transit staff in the status report, the City of Seattle supports continued development of the Denny/Westlake station refinements – both the “shifted north” and “shifted west” concepts – for further analysis and review. Both refinements make progress in reducing the impacts of full street closures, a key concern we heard at Board meetings from community members and business owners. Based on that metric alone, both refinements have introduced new approaches to allow for improved transit and vehicle access during construction.

However, we need to learn more before we consider advancing these new concepts. The South Lake Union “Harrison Street” station is projected to have high ridership and a critical connection to many bus routes. We need to understand how the “shifted west” consolidation plan would impact this ridership and transit integration. In their follow-up efforts, Sound Transit staff should communicate with stakeholders and work with King County Metro to ensure their feedback is incorporated before reporting back to the Board. The City of Seattle remains committed to the South Lake Union and Denny stations in this growing, economic hub for our region and the future riders these stations will serve.

The value of this work over the last 60 days has been validated with this status report and provides the staff team with a framework to complete the remaining analysis necessary in advance of the July Board meeting. The City of Seattle has been assured by Sound Transit staff that this necessary evaluation can be completed efficiently within the project schedule. The City of Seattle would not support this work if it added an undue burden to the Ballard Link Extension project schedule or other projects. We have a duty to our communities to mitigate construction impacts and the information we learn now can help us to avoid challenges further along in the process.

I support the staff suggested next steps to use the next two months to continue refining the Westlake DT-1 preferred alternative and encourage my Board member colleagues to join me in supporting their recommendation.

Chair Constantine and Sound Transit Board Members:

Having just been made aware of Sound Transit's further studies work on Denny Station, we would like to express our concerns about the new Westlake West option that would lead to the elimination of the South Lake Union station.

**We strongly object to a consolidation of stations, as that would severely impact access to a growing Seattle Center and the Uptown neighborhood.** A new Memorial Stadium, the possible addition of an NBA team, the continued need to help sustain the arts and cultural organizations on campus, and future residential growth will only increase the ridership projections for Seattle Center stations as the busiest of the entire system.

A station on the east side of the Seattle Center campus has been a given for years.

If the current South Lake Union station location at Harrison Street is technically off the table with the Westlake West option, we would be happy to collaborate with Sound Transit staff in locating an alternative location on the east side of Seattle Center, which must be done together with further work on this option.

**I am writing to strongly urge you to fully explore the Denny Westlake "Shifted West" light rail station option. Other proposed options (Draft EIS DT-1 and Shifted North) that include a full closure or significantly reduced access to Westlake Avenue for 4 to 10-plus years are untenable and would cause**



**catastrophic damage to FareStart's mission to transform lives, disrupt poverty and nourish communities, impacting the thousands of people we serve.**

Westlake Avenue is a critical route for cars, the Seattle streetcar, other public transportation vehicles and pedestrians --- and for FareStart. The proposed construction zone and full or partial Westlake closure are on the doorstep of our headquarters located at the triangle of Westlake, 7<sup>th</sup> Avenue and Virginia Street.

Any significant disruption to Westlake will impair the production and delivery of millions of FareStart meals to food-insecure people and communities across Puget Sound. The construction and reduced street access will also hinder the flow of customers to our dining and private event space, which we are reopening this year while providing job training to people experiencing homelessness and other barriers to employment. We are relying on this space to raise critical revenue to support our mission as we recover and reset from pandemic impacts.

We welcome more access to the Denny Triangle and South Lake Union neighborhoods via light rail but implore Sound Transit to thoroughly explore other options such as "Shifted West" that do not disrupt Westlake Avenue. It is imperative that Westlake remain operational for the financial health of FareStart and for the other organizations, businesses and residents who rely on this key thoroughfare in our community.

Hello Board Members,

I'm Betty Lau, co-founder of Transit Equity for All and board member of the Chong Wa Benevolent Association of Washington State. Chong Wa is the lead organization of the Chinese Community, headquartered in Chinatown.

As you consider route options, please think of access for seniors. For example, think of how to provide 1200+ resident seniors of the CID with easy access to light rail.

I'm hearing more and more that North & South of CID options won't be an issue because seniors will all be dead by the time light rail is built. That's Ageism and

stereotyping. That's like saying stop planning light rail to be here for a hundred years because most people alive now won't be around to use it!

Another stereotype I've heard is that seniors are so old they don't go anywhere. They just stay home and watch TV. As a senior myself, I am deeply offended.

Seniors are more active than you think. They go to doctor's appointments at hospitals and clinics for exams and treatments, mostly on 1<sup>st</sup> Hill. I know that because I've gone to act as interpreter. And many do travel, having relatives abroad, so direct access to the airport is important, particularly since we aren't getting a parking garage like other transit cities. But that's an equity issue for another day.

And the reverse is true: the senior population has many friends and relatives from out of town or outside the US--coming here to see them.

By-passing the CID doesn't make sense. Please! Get us off the National Most Endangered Historic Places list and Move Forward on 4<sup>th</sup>!

Dear Board Members:

We are writing on behalf of KWP, Inc., which is the owner of the property located at 201 Terry Avenue N. (TPN 1986200265) (the "Property") to provide comments on the Draft EIS for the WSBLE project. The Property is presently developed with a small office building and a surface parking lot. The Property is zoned SM-SLU 175/85-280, which indicates that a 28-story apartment building is feasible on the Property. Buildings of similar or greater scale have been developed in the immediate vicinity in the last five years.

We understand that the Sound Transit Board will receive a staff update on Thursday, May 25, 2023 considering the final location of a station in this area.

We support the retention of the preferred station location at Westlake "Block 48" preferably Westlake West. We previously stated we **do not support** the station location on Terry. We further **do not support** the Terry location due to the additional \$300 million in added costs for the station and the potential of a several-year closure of Westlake negatively impacting the business economy of the area.

This preferred station will be less expensive than the Denny alternative and we believe that traffic impacts to Westlake Avenue can be mitigated with careful planning. The Westlake Avenue station location is also in a superior position, being set in the middle of nearly 10 million s.f. of office space and hundreds of existing apartment and condo units – a much denser environment than at the alternative Denny location.

We appreciate the opportunity to provide these comments.

**An open letter to the Sound Transit Board of Directors, Julie Timm, CEO, and John Henry, CFO, concerning the plans to build a 1.2-mile dedicated eastbound bus lane (BAT) in Lake Forest Park.**

Over the past several months, Lake Forest Park residents and elected officials have attempted to make four points to the Sound Transit Board and Staff regarding the plan to build a 1.2-mile dedicated, eastbound BRT lane in Lake Forest Park, concerning:

The significant loss of property and the probable and significant adverse environmental impacts to our City.

The lack of meaningful engagement with the citizens of Lake Forest Park.

Lake Forest Park City Council's request for Sound Transit to "pause the project here for 90 days" to study alternatives.

Multiple requests from Lake Forest Park citizen groups to consider an alternative to a dedicated eastbound bus lane--build bus queue jumps (like the design on NE 145th Street) and signal priority along Bothell Way; redesign bus stops such that they are appropriate to neighborhoods, maximize tree conservation.

#### **Our Ask:**

**The citizens of Lake Forest Park deserve more complete answers to our questions than the broad generalities provided to us by the Sound Transit Staff. Specifically, we are asking the Sound Transit Board to instruct the Staff to do the following:**

• **Examine a third option. Specifically, instead of a dedicated 1.2-mile eastbound bus lane, utilize bus queue jumps (like the design on NE 145th Street) and signal priority along Bothell Way. Also, allow for smaller bus stop footprints at 153rd and 165th which have very small numbers of bus boardings. The presumption is this would substantially reduce construction costs, property takes and environmental impacts, while retaining 50%-80% of the transit time savings.**

#### **Documentation:**

The following write-up is derived from a series of documents obtained from the Sound Transit Website and through Public Records Requests. It details the enormous cost to taxpayers for the purpose of reducing the 522-bus transit time through Lake Forest Park on the afternoon weekday eastbound rush hour bus from South Shoreline Light Rail Station to Bothell by 2.3 minutes.

Assuming the figures used here are reasonably accurate compared to more current, undiscoverable cost analysis by City on the SR522/145th BRT, to us there seems to be a straightforward conclusion here. The gain--2.3 minutes estimated faster bus commute through Lake Forest Park--is not worth the pain. The enormous expense to obtain it, the fact that there are much less expensive design

alternatives, that Sound Transit has a multi-billion dollar "affordability gap," and that there is an obligation specified in the annual realignment review to look every year for cost-saving options to current plans all require the Sound Transit Board to Review the return on investment on this section of SR522/145<sup>th</sup> BRT running through Lake Forest Park to determine if there is a more cost-effective alternative. It is Sound Transit Board's fiduciary responsibility to the taxpayers as it is to the residents of Lake Forest Park, to act.

**1. How did Sound Transit choose the current design (BAT lane and the "West Shift") for Lake Forest Park?**

In 2019 and 2020, Sound Transit reviewed three alternative design approaches here:

**March 2019:**

***Option 1: Refinement 1 Lake Forest Park "Safe Highways" Preferred.*** This refinement calls for a 1.2-mile dedicated eastbound BAT lane running exclusively on the east side of Bothell Way.

***Option 2: Refinement Alignment 2.*** This refinement would have the eastbound BAT lane run about half the distance on Bothell Way, from NE 155th to just past 41st Street south, almost to the Town Center.

**Early 2020:**

***Lake Forest Park "West Shift" design.*** Sound Transit announced it was "considering a shift of roadway widening to the west side of SR 522 to reduce property impacts and ensure more residents can maintain access to their homes."

**June 2020:**

***Sound Transit selects refinement 1 with the "West Shift" design.*** even though it acknowledges it "costs more," citing the following limited rationale: Shifting the roadway widening to the west allows more property owners to stay in their homes and minimizes the overall change to the neighborhood." They could avoid as many as "6 full property acquisitions".  
"Making use of existing right-of-way reduces the need for property purchases."  
"Widening SR 522 exclusively on the east side of the road between 38th Avenue NE and 41st Avenue NE in Lake Forest Park could cause significant impacts to driveways."

No documentation was discovered that explains the process or analysis done selecting the "Refinement 1" along with the "West Shift design change, analysis that examined:

Cost of property acquisitions (not right of way), including total private properties impacted (the number of partial and full), the total square footage required, and the estimated cost of acquiring the properties.

Construction costs and time to build.

Comparative reduction of bus transit times.

The number of tree removals required.

The need for, extent, and cost of retaining walls required for each design.

**September 22, 2021**, immediately after the completion of Sound Transit's "Realignment Process," the Board unanimously approved Resolution R2021-07 making SR522/145th BRT a "project to be built" at the cost of \$544mm.

Two years later, the cost had increased 25% to \$651 million, with warnings additional cost increases and delays were likely.

## **2. Lack of Public Engagement: Sound Transit Community Outreach efforts in Lake Forest Park.**

### ***Open Houses/Community Meetings:***

Only 2 Sound Transit SR 522/145<sup>th</sup> BRT Community Open House Meetings were held since the "West Shift" design decision, one in 2020 and another in March 2021. They generated 458 comments (emails, notes on yellow stickies, and written comments); only 47 people from Lake Forest Park attended the 2021 Open House.

Sound Transit announced plans to hold an Open House in Lake Forest Park on Wednesday, March 15, 2023 from 3-7 pm—an inconvenient time for parents and working people, guaranteeing limited participation at this open house.

### ***Community Outreach:***

Sound Transit staff have continuously conflated legally required contacts with property owners concerning property acquisitions with "community outreach." Sound Transit Staff reported 550 inquiries received from residents and homeowners in Lake Forest Park over the past two years, providing no facts or figures as to the source or subject of the inquiries but suggesting many of these were related to property acquisitions.

### ***SR522/145th BRT Elected Leadership Committee:***

The SR522/145<sup>th</sup> Elected Leadership Committee has not met since February 22, 2019. Of the members listed on Sound Transit's website, three of the five members no longer serve on their respective City Councils; two of the three Sound Transit Board members listed no longer serve on the Sound Transit Board. No meetings are currently scheduled.

## **How much is Sound Transit spending in Lake Forest Park to build SR522/145<sup>th</sup> BRT?**

The document "Phase 1 Refinement Report" dated March 2019 (pg. 5.2) has breakouts of costs by City for "property acquisition" and "cost of construction and construction management."

### ***It shows the disproportionate investment in Lake Forest Park.***

Of the estimated (adjusted for inflation) cost of \$145mm for property acquisitions, 67% is spent in Lake Forest Park.

Of the estimated cost of \$318mm construction and construction management, 49% is spent in Lake Forest Park.

Of the estimated \$464mm total cost of property acquisitions and construction) on SR522/145<sup>th</sup> BRT, 55% is spent on LFP.

It costs \$148mm per mile for roadway in Lake Forest Park, 2.8 times the average for the entire SR522/145<sup>th</sup> BRT.

It costs \$109mm per minute of saved bus transit time in Lake Forest Park (2.3 minutes), 2.1 times the average for the entire SR522/145<sup>th</sup> BRT.

In addition, 54% of the 204 homes and business owners on SR522/145<sup>th</sup> BRT required to give up all or part of their property are in Lake Forest Park accounting for 67% of the total cost of property acquisitions and permits.

#### How much dirt and topsoil excavation and fill needs to happen to build SR522/145<sup>th</sup> BRT?

- Sound Transit's SEPA Environmental Check List, March 2021 page 42 provides details on the amount of excavation and fill that must take place by City. The chart below shows the details:

- A total of 139,840 cubic yards of material, mostly dirt and topsoil, must be hauled away and hauled in to complete the project. The average weight of a cubic yard of dirt and topsoil is one ton.
- 64% or 90,000 cubic feet of this material to be hauled away and moved in is in Lake Forest Park.
- Assuming the maximum capacity of a dump truck is 19 cubic feet, it means that a minimum of 4,737 dump truck loads are required in Lake Forest Park alone.
- If the work were to take a full year, it would require 100 dump truck loads in and out of Lake Forest Park each week for 52 weeks.
- The impact to SR522, the noise, damage to the environment and roadway are not documented in the Sound Transit SEPA Environmental Checklist document. D

**How much does the dedicated 1.2-mile eastbound bus lane in Lake Forest Park contribute to the**

**estimated 15.7-minute reduced bus transit time during the eastbound PM weekday rush hour bus trip from the South Shoreline Light Rail Station to Bothell?**

The spreadsheet **SR522BRTBus2024and2042NoBuildandBuildTravelTimesummary.xls** has detailed transit time estimates by intersection "build Vs. no-build" for PM weekday peak hours. It shows:

Lake Forest Park contributes an average of 2.3 minutes (15%) to the total 15.7 minutes, **with an eastbound BAT Lane.**

62% (9.7 of the 15.7 total minutes saved) occurs in the 145th St section, **which has no BAT lanes.**

50% (7.9 minutes) of the total 15.7-minute faster bus transit time is saved in the 13 blocks from the South Shoreline Light Rail Station to NE 145<sup>th</sup> St and 15<sup>th</sup> Ave NE, where there is no BAT lane.

**Without BAT lanes**, the bus's average speed on 145<sup>th</sup> increases 133% from 4.8 MPH (no build) to 11.2 MPH (with build). **With an eastbound BAT lane**, the bus speed in Lake Forest Park increases 33% from 10.7 MPH/no build to 14.2 MPH w/build.

**What is the status of SR522/145<sup>th</sup> BRT? Based on the Agency Progress Report Capital Programs published December 2022, pg. 168:**

The current forecast for (SR522/145th BRT) completion is Q4 2027, or a total of 10 months past the Sound Transit Board realignment milestone. The realignment schedule is aggressive, and staff have routinely informed the Board that the current schedule is inconsistent with the target and affordable schedule.



It's not too late to compare the cost and benefit of the Queue Jump Proposal to the current 60% Design Package with an analysis of the real impacts to our City: tree removal, continuous tall retaining walls, property acquisitions and roadway noise. The Sound Transit Board has a fiduciary responsibility it has so far failed to exercise. It has the obligation outlined in the annual realignment process to step in now and to do the right thing for taxpayers, transit riders, and the City of Lake Forest Park.

I have been asked to comment on ST3 transit expansion on Bothell Way in Lake Forest Park by homeowners fronting HWY 522 being asked to negotiate Acquisition and Easement contracts.

During my over 20 year tenure as founder and owner of Goodbye Graffiti in Seattle, I have seen the success and failure of different transit routes firsthand. Most recently we were contracted by Sound Transit for graffiti removal at 42 Sound Transit stations along with many other continuing contracts. My observation of similar urbanist projects leads to a stark conclusion about these proposed Lake Forest Park expansions, especially with no planned street and sidewalk lighting.

The most blatant problems from my considerable experience are given as follows:

- This section is extremely poorly lit at night, which has already led to a fair amount of property crime in the area. Night time is completely dark along most of this stretch.
- Being poorly lit, it feels unsafe for pedestrians to and from transit opportunities, is a graffiti magnet, litter will follow and fulfills every prerequisite for a greater influx of crime.
- Crime damages the usability of transit and degrades the neighborhood. Crime also tends to attract more of itself. That degeneration will only hurt the area's success in transit use.
- The long, large retaining walls and flat surface as proposed are a huge "palette" for gang and wantabe graffiti artists. This part of the project could not be a more tempting target!

These problems generally follow a pattern, first observed and then those that naturally follow from the preceding problem. Graffiti is a sign of urban decay. It is widely known that graffiti itself is the precursor to even greater issues. In my many years of work and observation in Seattle and surrounding areas, all of these above instances have been notable. The pattern is clear.

There are a few ways to mitigate the issues outlined above that have proven to be effective:

- Sidewalk lighting would be a powerful deterrent right now, but an absolute necessity for the added foot traffic as sidewalks are added, especially with less natural light in winter.
- An active maintenance plan and upkeep of the large walls and sidewalk border plants is essential to keeping the area safe and therefore keeping transit more accessible for all.
- Eyes on the street are essential to deter graffiti and crime. A lower speed limit generates less traffic noise and pedestrians feel safer, leading to more use of sidewalks and transit.

I hope my experience and thoughts can guide the city of Lake Forest Park toward a better plan.

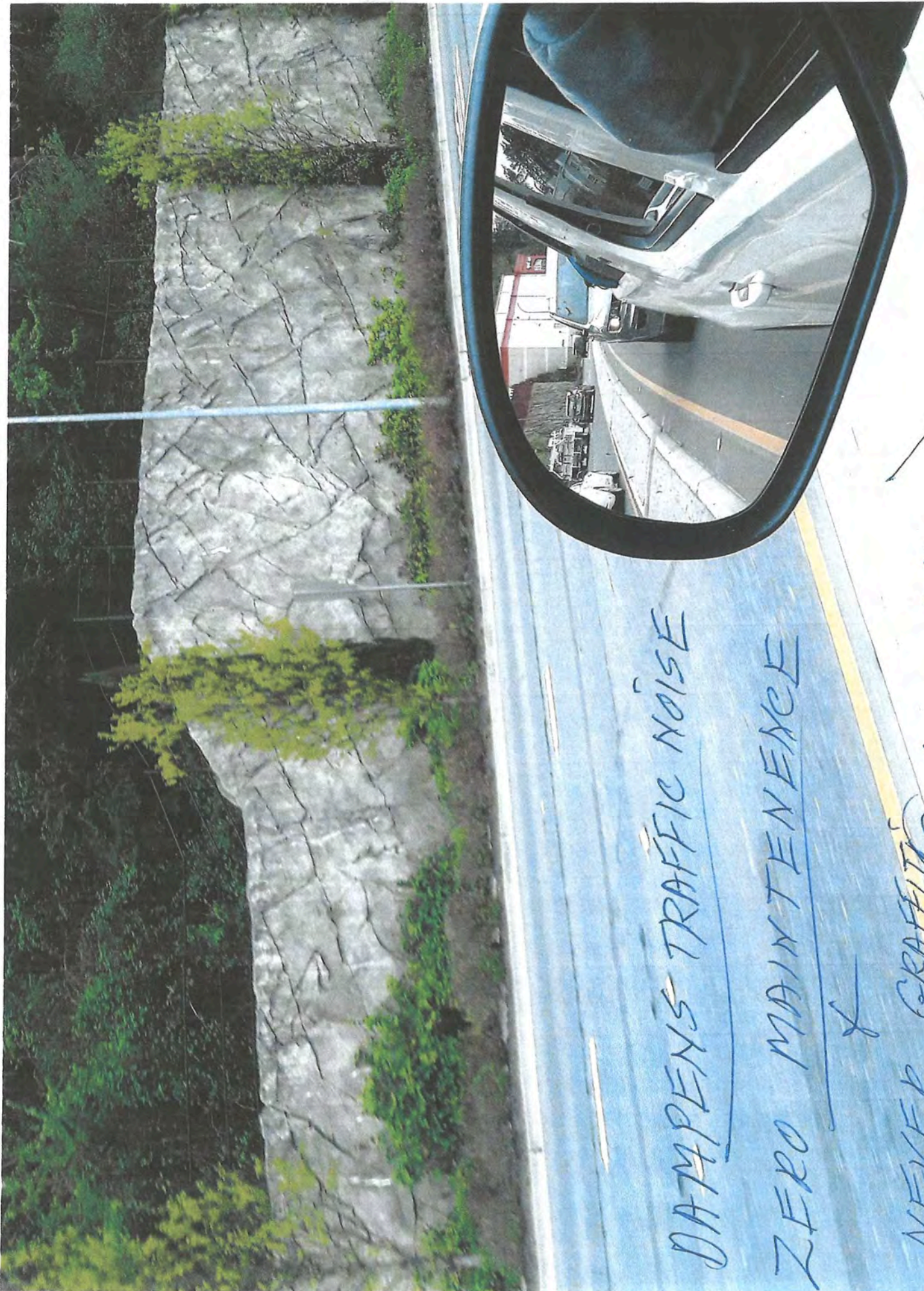
