Summary of TAG recommendations

CEO Sparrman: We are unequivocally committed to creatively, effectively, and urgently implementing the TAG recommendations.

Recommendation 1:

Rebuild trust and clarify Board and staff roles and responsibilities.

Recommendation 2:

Introduce an experienced megaproject capital program executive team.

Recommendations 3 & 4:

• Internal improvements, including accelerating decision-making and applying industry best practices to reduce unnecessary process.

Recommendation 5:

Strengthen and enforce an agency betterments policy.

Recommendation 6:

Engage the FTA as a delivery partner equally invested in delivering regional transit.



Rebuild trust and clarify the roles and responsibilities of the ST Board & Staff

March/End of Q1

- Staff report template, with staff recommendations and cost and schedule impacts, will be presented for feedback.
- Begin Board engagement to develop a programmatic workplan focused on system-wide issues and decisions.

End of Q2 2024

- Engage the Board to finalize a workplan focusing on systemwide issues and decisions.
- Implement cost and schedule impact analysis to staff reports and recommendations.

Key Progress Updates

- CEO Sparrman eliminated a previous internal policy requiring CEO signature authority on a high volume of contracts, empowering appropriate levels of staff to move forward with contract execution.
- Successful Board Retreat, focused on regional support and collaboration.



Introduce an experienced megaproject capital program executive team.

March/End of Q1

- Complete offer and contract negotiation for new DCEO Mega Capital Projects.
- Post ST2 & ST3 Deputy Executive Director positions and formally begin recruiting.
- CEO will develop proposal for organizational refinement.

End of Q2 2024

- Complete recruitment and interview process for Deputy Executive Director positions.
- Implement new organizational framework.

Key Progress Update

- CEO completed an internal review of Agency organizational structure.
- Interview process continues for DCEO Mega Capital Projects Delivery.



Recommendations 3 & 4

Internal improvements

March/End of Q1

- Implementation and reporting set in motion for 30-day invoice processing.
- Set agency-wide expectations on new processes, including clarity on roles with resident engineers, 60-day change order processing and 120-day project closeout for A&E contracts.
- Implement additional changes to the internal Change Control Board.

End of Q2 2024

 Conduct training and introduce system refinements related to invoice processing, change order processing and contract closeout.

Key progress update

 First round of reforms complete for the internal Change Control Board to streamline its scope and processes to empower project teams.



Strengthen and enforce an agency betterment policy.

March/End of Q1

- Draft Scope Control Policy to consolidate agency betterments policies from across the agency and propose to Board for consideration.
- Incorporate Board feedback on the proposed policy.
- Station Design Standards consultant transmitted Task 2 technical report on inventory and an evaluation of existing issues and concerns.

End of Q2 2024

 Subject to Board concurrence, pass updated Scope Control Policy and begin integration of betterments policy into projects.

Key progress updates

 Board leadership and TAG briefed on final policy memo, informing the drafting of the updated Scope Control Policy.



Engage the FTA as a delivery partner equally invested in delivering regional transit.

March/End of Q1

FEIS schedules will be finalized of OMF South, WSLE and BLE.

End of Q2 2024

 CEO will lead ongoing relationship building with regional administration and national FTA leadership in Washington D.C.

Key progress update

 Review of the FTA/ST relationship map completed to inform ongoing planning to streamline the respective agencies' collaboration.
