## Business items

### For Committee Final Action

Motion No. M2025-25: Related to authorizing the agency to join as a plaintiff in the litigation Martin Luther King, Jr. County, Pierce County, Snohomish County, City of Boston et. al v. U.S. Departments of Transportation, Federal Transit Administration, et. al., No. 2:25-cv-814 (W.D. Wash. filed May 2, 2025)

**It was moved by Board member Backus and seconded by Vice Chair Mello.**

General Counsel Desmond Brown noted that the action would allow the agency to join litigation against the federal government to seek an injunction to protect the agency from being required to comply with new grant requirements related to the cooperation with federal immigration officials as well as new restrictions on agency diversity, equity, and inclusion programs.

Chair Somers noted that he felt the agency must take this measure to protect itself, although it is not an action that is gladly taken.

**It was carried by the unanimous vote of all Board members present that Motion No. M2025-25 be adopted.**


