
What is BRT?

High-capacity bus-based transit system that delivers fast, comfortable, and cost-effective service:

- ✓ Lower capital cost than rail
- ✓ Scalable and flexible routes
- ✓ Dedicate lanes
- ✓ Signal Prioritization
- ✓ Multimodal connectivity

Why are we here today

- Motion No. M2025-24: Seeking the Committee's do-pass recommendation to execute construction contract for Bus Base North Operations and Maintenance Facility
- This action is funded by the current project budget and there is sufficient budget projected to fund the remaining work.
- Project is included in the existing Long Range Financial Plan.

Total authorized not-to-exceed amount: \$274,013,186 (includes 20% contingency)

Bus Base North Operations and Maintenance Facility

Operations Building: administration, operations controls and dispatch, training and storage.

Parking and Servicing Building: bus parking and charging, fuel and wash to accommodate up to 120 double-decker and articulated buses. Employee parking.

Vehicle Maintenance Building: parts and storage, chassis wash, tire storage and repair. Maintenance personnel work area.

Supports both battery and diesel bus fleet.



The over 365,000 square foot facility is situated on a 12.5-acre site in Canyon Park

- Design is Complete.
- Total Project Budget: \$499.5M (includes hard and soft costs).
- 3 bids all within the project budget


