Notable updates since last month

Schedule:

- **DRLE:** Opened for service on May 10.
- **WSLE:** NEPA Record of Decision (ROD) issued on April 29.
- **BLE:** DEIS issuance delayed; targeting Q3 2025 publication.
- **TDLE:** Published DEIS Comment Summary report. Board will confirm, modify, or identify preferred alternative in June 2025.

Active procurements:

- **OMF:** Progressive Design-Build.
- **MATOC:** Environmental and Design.
- **Union Station:** Fire Detection & Alarm System Replacement.
- **Kent Garage:** Concrete Restoration construction project (State of Good Repair).
- **Stride BRT:** Construction for BT105 Renton TC, BT305 Seattle/Shoreline SR523 Stations & Roadwork, and BT307 Kenmore/Bothell SR 522 Roadwork & Stations.

Construction Safety

Pinehurst Station Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) recordable injury Incident occurred in April 2025.

- Recordable Injury Rate (RIR) remained yellow due to Pinehurst incident.
- Lost-Time Injury Rate (LTIR) changed from red to green due to more labor hours this month.

Pinehurst Station Incident: An apprentice electrician sustained a laceration to his left index finger while cutting an overhead all-thread rod with a portable band saw. After receiving first aid, he was transported by vehicle to NW Hospital. An X-ray was performed, the wound was stitched, and he was discharged after treatment.

Corrective Actions:

- Contractor provided "Safe use of Power Tools" refresher training to the electricians.
- Whenever possible, assign a designated person to rectify all thread rods at the cutting station or a worktable to prevent cutting in any awkward position.
