



2024 Annual Environmental and Sustainability Targets


2024 target completion status



2024 Highlight - Planet


Providing significant environmental benefits

- In 2024, 1 ton of ST GHG emissions avoids nearly 5 tons of GHG in region.
- 18% more emissions avoided compared to 2023.
- Offset significantly more GHG than emitted.


